PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT BOARD MEETINGS (Policy BEDH)

- Any individual desiring to address the Governing Board shall complete this form and give it to the District Secretary prior to the start of the Governing Board meeting.
- The Governing Board meeting is subject to the Arizona Open Meeting Law
- The Governing Board will not respond to comments or presentations made in the Call to the Audience, but may refer matters to its staff or to District personnel for study of recommendations.
- The Board President (or designee) shall be responsible for recognizing speakers, maintaining proper order, and adherence to any time limit set. Questions of fact asked by the public shall, when appropriate, be answered immediately by the President (or designee) or referred to staff members present for reply; questions requiring investigation shall be referred to the Superintendent for later report to the board.
- During an open session the Board shall not hear personal complaints against school personnel or any person connected with the school system unless other procedures provided by the Board for disposition of legitimate complaints involving individuals have been followed.
- Undue interruption or other interference with the orderly conduct of a meeting of the Governing Board will not be permitted.
